# NATO CEPC

- CEP - Civil Emergency Planning
- CEPC – CEP Committee
- Pool of Civilian experts to support NATO
- Already done - Evaluation of Ukrainian NPP-s



# NATO IRCSG

- IRCSG – Industrial Resources and Communications Services Group – Industry subgroup
- Research and workshops on CIP
- Some very active countries like **Poland!**
- Good contacts, such as **U.S. DHS**
- Most active country is **Switzerland**, which is not member of NATO!
- **Ukraine** is member of group

COE - Centre's of Excellence

- Not in chain of command of NATO
- Directed by supporting nations
- All together 24 and new ones coming
- Each with different topic:
  - cyber-defence
  - strategic communication
  - defense against terrorism
  - military engineering

- Lithuania as framework nation
- Also Latvia, Estonia, France, Italy, Turkey, Georgia (non-NATO), Czech (VNC), U.S. (joining in process)
