



Anatoliy Stepanovych Halchynskiy (1935-2022)

The known Ukrainian scientist-economist, statesman, Doctor of Economic Sciences, Professor, Honored Scientist and Technologist of Ukraine.
Honorary Doctor of the National Institute for Strategic Studies.

A. Halchynskiy was born on November 3, 1935, in Bohuslav, Kyiv region.

In 1964, he graduated from the Economics Faculty of Kyiv Taras Shevchenko National University.

In 1970, completed his postgraduate studies at the Academy of Social Sciences under the Central Committee of the Communist Party of the Soviet Union.

From 1975 to 1988, served as the head of the Political Economy Department at Kyiv Pedagogical Institute of Foreign Languages.

From 1988 to 1991, was a professor at the Department of Political Economy of the Institute of Political Science and Sociology of Management.

From 1991 to 1992, headed the Department of Monetary and Currency Relations at Taras Shevchenko National University of Kyiv.

From 1992 to 1994, headed of the Department of International Monetary and Financial Problems at the Institute of World Economy and International Relations of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine.

From 1994 to 2005, served as an Advisor to the President of Ukraine on Macroeconomic Policy. Simultaneously, from December 1996 to July 1997, he was the Deputy Head of the Presidential Administration of Ukraine on Economic Policy.

From 2000 to 2005, was the Director of the National Institute for Strategic Studies, and during the same period, chaired the Council of the National Bank of Ukraine.

From 2005 to 2008, served as the Scientific Director of the Institute for Strategic Assessments.

A. Halchynskiy has authored more than 150 scientific works.
