

Authors' Instructions

Authors must refer to, and abide by, the following instructions in submitting their Conference Papers:

Your Conference Papers should be 4 – 6 pages long and submitted before the paper submission deadline, in Ukrainian or English, and fit within one of the conference topics.

Conference Papers should include the following mandatory elements (presented in the order as they appear in the manuscript):

- UDC Index;
- Title of the papers in Ukrainian and English (IN CAPITAL LETTERS);
- Author's information in Ukrainian and English, namely: surname, first name, patronymic (in full), academic degree, academic title, full job title, workplace (full name of institution or company), place of residence, country; email address; ORCID;
- The Papers should follow the research paper structure as follows: Abstract (+keywords), Introduction, problem statement, and study aim, Review of the Literature, Methodology, results and conclusion/ discussion, References list using the Paper Writing Template.
- The papers should be concise and clearly state the problem statement, proposed research study's purpose, presentation of key research findings, results, and conclusions (subheadings should not be indicated);
- List of References arranged in alphabetical order, formatted according to DSTU 8302-2015.

References in the text of the Papers are indicated in square brackets, specifying the source number from the list of references and, if necessary, the page number (e.g., [7, p. 11]). Footnotes and endnotes are formatted on a per-page basis, automatically in Microsoft Word.

Figures and tables should be positioned directly after the paragraph where they are first mentioned or on the following page. Figures should have captions and table titles should be provided. The figure title is placed below the figure, centered, and in bold font (e.g., "Fig. 1. Title"). Tables are identified as "Table," numbered with Arabic numerals, and table titles are highlighted in bold font. Landscape orientation is not used for figures and tables.

Drawings (schematics) created using the built-in Microsoft Word drawing editor should be presented as grouped objects. Tables and figures should together comprise no more than one-third of the total content of the Papers.

The text should be typed in Microsoft Word text editor without any header using Times New Roman font, size 14, with a line spacing of 1.5. The margins should be standard: top and bottom - 2 cm, left - 3 cm, right - 1.5 cm. The paragraph indentation should be set to 1.25 cm.
